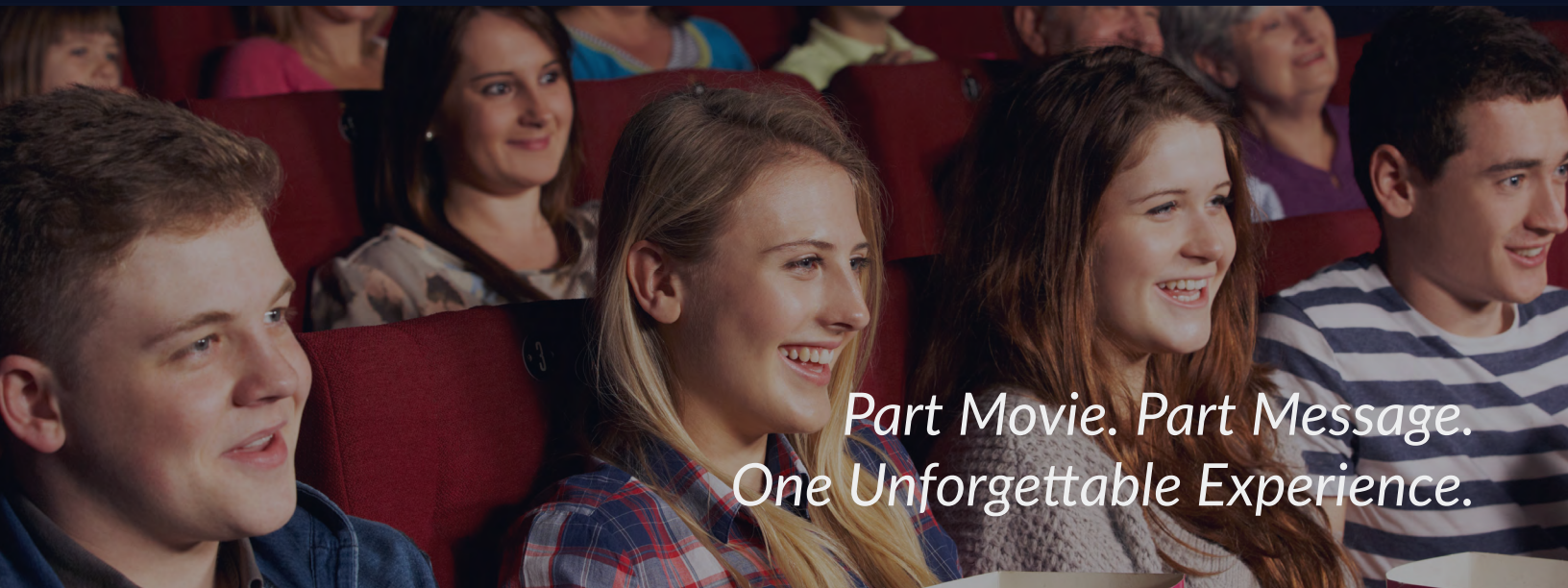

Sermon Script - Own It

We've put together an incredible message based on specific scriptures and themes. We're handing this over to you in a Word document, so you can make this sermon your own. Ultimately, you're the one presenting the message, so you want to make sure it sounds like you. You want to keep it relevant to your audience, and you can even change how you talk about the theme we've covered in the script.

The Word document also allows you to easily copy and paste the script into a teleprompter app, so you can read the script while you're on camera.
